Governor Kim Reynolds's government realignment bill is nothing short of a power grab. The two-person subcommittees, which skirted open meeting laws, got zero public or expert input into what to do with which boards. Now, they are proposing eliminating over 100 boards and commissions. Iowans value health and safety and the opportunities for all to thrive. The elimination of these boards and commissions would allow corporations, polluters and bad actors free reign to harm Iowans.
